

With just 132 luxurious ocean-front suites onboard, guests will explore the world's most exquisite destinations in Seabourn's incomparable elegance and ease. Designed and built for diverse environments to PC6 Polar Class standards, both ships feature a brand-new innovative design, incorporating many features that have made Seabourn ships so successful. Two custom-built, 6-seater submarines provide an unforgettable view of the world beneath the ocean's surface, a complement of kayaks and 24 Zodiacs can accommodate all guests at once, allowing for a truly immersive experience... all alongside a crew that includes an outstanding and well-travelled expedition team comprised of highly regarded wilderness experts, scientists, historians and naturalists.



Seabourn Venture's 2023 and 2024 seasons include expeditions to the Arctic, Antarctica and the Amazon where you may cruise in Zodiacs under teeming bird cliffs and along jungle rivers, kayak among stately icebergs and tropical coral islands. Visit Viking ruins, ancient Inca sites and remote villages. View whales, walrus and seals up close and cruise in submarines past vivid reef walls and towering underwater ice cliffs. Snorkel unspoilt tropical coral gardens glittering with iridescent fish, trek to earth-shaking waterfalls and shining blue-white glaciers.



Uncover boundless beauty and wonder as you travel between continents and across oceans. In Spring 2023, sail from Brazil's golden beaches and thrilling cities to the remote beauty of the Cape Verde islands. Call on cities built with Spanish Colonial style and infused with history. Venture from New World to Old, as you chart a north easterly course for sunny Las Palmas, captivating Lisbon and iconic Greenwich, London.

Then discover Britain's remotest islands with Seabourn Venture as your guide. Explore the wild and rugged Orkney and Shetland Islands, home to a wide variety of wildlife and UNESCO world heritage sites. Fair Isle for example, famous for its' sweaters, is home to just 55 residents, while at uninhabited Mousa Island you may take an included Zodiac tour to visit the mysterious prehistoric Broch and see the largest known colony of European storm-petrels.

In direct contrast, in spring 2024, Seabourn Venture will sail from Cape Verde to Malaga via North Africa's fascinating and diverse countries; then hug the cultural coasts of Iberia and France on her way to Greenwich.

Taking in views of rugged mountains, ice-blue glaciers, and lush greenery is one of the most sought-after activities for expedition travellers. Experience nature's seasonal extravagance in Svalbard, Iceland, Greenland, and the Canadian Arctic.

Cruise in Zodiacs under teeming bird cliffs and kayak among tall, stately icebergs under the Midnight Sun. Thread a kayak among sculpted icebergs and observing the whales, walruses, seals, reindeer, polar bears and more that fill this remote region with life.

Visit Viking ruins and ancient Inuit sites. Explore Svalbard's breathtaking fjords, immense Icelandic waterfalls, the grandeur of Greenland's glaciers and polar bear-haunted beaches in remote Baffin Bay and Nunavut.



THE NORTHWEST PASSAGE, ALASKA & THE PACIFIC COAST

For centuries, explorers were obsessed with unlocking two legendary sea routes linking the Atlantic and Pacific oceans. the Northwest Passage through the Canadian Arctic and the Northeast Passage along the Arctic coasts of Norway and Russia. Yet the Arctic has experienced monumental change since these passages were first mapped, and the region's transformative nature has created ice-free areas year-round, making shipping, and expedition travel, possible.

Now, you may join an elite group to traverse one of the most wildly beautiful places on Earth – the Northwest Passage. Activities through the passage will be flexible, as the ice determines where and how we proceed. Witness polar bears and other fascinating wildlife. Become immersed in a wonderland of rugged tundra, historical remains and modern Inuit customs. Explore by Zodiac, kayak and submersible, using your ship as a home base to experience the wild passages of the North.

Take an exhilarating Zodiac excursion along the Ilulissat Icefjord, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit Inuit towns in Canada's Nunavut territory, and learn how Indigenous people survive in such a remote and harsh environment. Wherever possible, Seabourn guests can join their ship's Kayak Team for an optional paddle. You can even explore below the frigid water surface in one of your ship's custom-built submarines.

Discover Alaska's extraordinary glaciers, mountain scenery, wildlife, cultural heritage and Gold rush history, then head south along California's golden coasts to Mexico.

Custom-Built Submarines

Piloted by experienced and licensed Expedition Team submariners, two six-person submarines offer guests breath-taking views of everything from the surreal subsea realms beneath Antarctic waters, plunging underwater cliffs in fjords, and reef walls teeming with life in clear, tropical seas. These rare experiences are available for an additional charge in select destinations.

These amazing watercrafts provide our means for landing on trackless beaches, desert isles and far-flung icy shores where no docks or other facilities exist. They carry guests to towering fjords, among breaching whales and stately icebergs, into jungledraped channels and untouched coral reefs. Our fleet of 24 Zodiacs can all gather beside the water-level shell doors on either side of Seabourn Venture, enabling call guests to enjoy a complimentary Zodiac tour at once.



Double Sea kayaks

These silent craft allow guests to approach wildlife at eye level, to enjoy the snaps of brash ice in a glacier's meltwater, to navigate tangled mangrove thickets teeming with life and slide over multicolored tropical coral gardens. Led by an expert member of our Expedition Team, these excursions offer an appealing option available for an additional charge.



Snorkelling and Scuba Gear

An array of masks, snorkels and fins assures everyone a good fit. Expedition Team members can help beginners get started and show you the best snorkelling spots during warm weather voyages. Scuba divers with an advanced or higher

qualification may go diving in select locations around the world. Seabourn Venture will provide tanks and weight belts. All dives will be led by a qualified

divemaster.
